Explanation of Responses:

- Performance Shares awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. 1/3 of the shares awarded vest immediately upon receipt. The remaining shares vest in 1/3 increments on each of the first and second anniversaries of the grant date. Under certain circumstances some or all of the vested shares may be settled in cash on a 1 for 1 basis based on the cash value of the underlying stock on the date of vesting.
- Vested amount includes the first 1/3 of the current grant, the second 1/3 of the grant made in January 2007 and the third and final 1/3 of the grant made in January 2006.
- Balance includes 3,618 shares held in the Employee Stock Purchase Plan.
- Shares withheld by the Issuer for reporting person's tax obligation.
- Vested performance shares settled in cash on a 1 for 1 basis.
- Shares held as of 12/31/2007 in a multi-fund 401(k) Plan to be settled in cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment for any reason on a 1:1 basis. Shares are acquired through regular periodic contributions, company matching contributions, and the automatic reinvestment of dividends.
- Non qualified employee stock options, awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. Options vest in 1/4 increments on each of the first four anniversaries of the grant date, referenced in column one, and expire on the tenth anniversary of the grant date.
